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OBJETIVOS DEL CONCURSO

- Estimular el trabajo individual y la sana competencia con otros alumnos, tanto de su colegio como de otros.

PARTICIPANTES

Todos los alumnos de cualquier centro educativo de España y de cualquier curso de primaria.

Habrán 2 grupos de participación:

- Grupo 1 (1º, 2º y 3º de primaria)
- Grupo 2 (4º, 5º y 6º de primaria)

Con la inscripción, el alumno recibirá, por parte de Amco Iberia, el orden y grupo de participación, así como el horario y los enlaces de acceso.

DE PARTICIPACIÓN
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Es este apartado daremos a conocer el funcionamiento del concurso, así como todo lo necesario para optar a la participación en el Amco Spelling Bee -Open Edition-.

CATEGORÍA

En el concurso, solo habrá una categoría en la que participarán sus alumnos. Cada colegio debe elegir a su mejor representante, por grupos, para el concurso de deletreo. Es decir, un único representante del Grupo 1 (entre los estudiantes de 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades) y un único representante del Grupo 2 (entre los participantes de 4th, 5th and 6th grades).

DINÁMICA DEL CONCURSO

- **Competición online:** Todos los participantes inscritos competirán entre sí, en diferentes rondas eliminatorias, hasta que queden solo 2 concursantes en cada grupo, el 1º y 2º clasificado.

El concurso tendrá lugar durante el día 24 de abril de 2021
a través de la plataforma online [Zoom](#).

La final será emitida en directo desde nuestro canal de Youtube (Amco Iberia) para que tanto familiares como amigos de los participantes puedan verlo en vivo.



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DESARROLLO DEL CONCURSO

Orden de participación

A medida que los participantes vayan confirmando su participación, la organización les adjudicará un número de participante: 01, 02, 03, 04... ese será el orden en el que deletrearán las palabras durante el concurso.

En función de la asistencia definitiva el día de la competición, el número que determina el orden de participación puede variar.

En la llamada, habrá:

- A. Emcee (maestro de ceremonias)
- B. Pronouncer
- C. Jueces
- D. Time Keeper

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PALABRAS

Las palabras usadas durante el concurso se detallan en los documentos Anexos A y B, adjuntos a estas bases de participación.

La organización, en exclusiva, contará con un listado de palabras extras numeradas para cada grupo, del que se hará uso en caso de que los alumnos no cometan error en el deletreo de las palabras, se prolonguen en exceso el número de rondas de deletreo de palabras por grupo, o, si por falta de tiempo, así lo estipulara el jurado.

Cada palabra de este listado de palabras extras también contará con la definición de la palabra y una oración en la que dicha palabra se use en contexto para que, si el concursante tiene duda sobre cómo se deletrea, poder pedir la definición u oración.

ELECCIÓN DE PALABRAS

Para asegurar que la elección de las palabras sea totalmente imparcial, se realizará del modo siguiente:

- Habrá una bolsa con todas las palabras de ambos grupos
- Habrá tantas tarjetas como número de palabras hay en cada listado numeradas del 1 al 150 (Grupo 1) y del 1 al 200 (Grupo 2).

Bajo ningún concepto, los participantes pueden ver las palabras escritas mientras dura el concurso. Sólo la persona que lee las palabras dispondrá del listado correspondiente.



REGLAS
DE PARTICIPACIÓN
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REGLAS DE PARTICIPACIÓN

1. No se permite la grabación de vídeo ni audio por parte de ningún dispositivo ajeno a la organización.
2. Se deberán aceptar los permisos (por parte de los tutores legales o padre/madre) de imagen y publicación en las redes sociales de la organización.
3. Deberán participar en la Final a través de una llamada de Zoom con el número de participación, nombre y apellido (p.e. 12 Carlos García).
4. Los micrófonos serán activados solo para participar al escuchar el número de participante. Se mantendrán en silencio el resto del tiempo.
5. Durante toda la competición, el participante deberá mirar a la cámara, manteniendo sus manos visibles.
6. El participante mantendrá un brazo de distancia entre su cuerpo y el dispositivo.
7. Familiares o audiencia no podrán ayudar a los estudiantes visual ni auditivamente.
8. Si los jueces notan que el participante recibe ayuda, quedará descalificado.
9. Si los jueces notan que la mirada del participante no se mantiene en el objetivo de la cámara durante su participación, se dará una advertencia. Si volviera a suceder, el participante quedará descalificado.
10. El concurso se desarrollará puntualmente, por lo que no se esperará a ningún participante.



*Si la conexión no es óptima cuando da comienzo el concurso (vídeo y audio), el alumno participará al final de la primera ronda de deletreo de su grupo. Si para entonces los problemas técnicos persisten, el concursante quedará eliminado.

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DURANTE EL CONCURSO

Cada participante tendrá que deletrear correctamente la palabra que corresponda al número extraído al azar por el Pronouncer y tendrá un máximo de 1 minuto para deletrear cada palabra desde que el concursante abra la palabra. El participante, conectará su micrófono antes de escuchar la palabra. Tras oírla, tendrá que pronunciarla, deletrearla y volver a pronunciarla mirando al objetivo de la cámara; ningún participante será eliminado por pronunciar mal la palabra. El tiempo comenzará a contar desde el momento en que el concursante abra la palabra y acabará cuando el participante cierre la palabra, tras haberla deletreado. El tiempo transcurrido será proyectado.

En la llamada, habrá:

- A. Emcee (maestro de ceremonias) y Pronouncer
- B. Jueces
- C. Time Keeper

El deletreo incorrecto de una palabra eliminará al concursante del certamen de forma inminente, es decir, en el momento en que cometa el error. Una vez eliminado, el concursante desaparecerá de la pantalla. En estos casos, el siguiente alumno por orden de participación deletreará una palabra distinta.

Antes de pronunciar la palabra que va a deletrear, si un participante tiene duda sobre cómo se deletrea puede pedir:

1. La definición de la palabra o
2. Una oración en la que la palabra se use en contexto

El concursante solo puede usar una vez cada opción en cada palabra.





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Para evitar posibles problemas de comprensión, es recomendable hacer énfasis en aquellas letras cuya pronunciación es más problemática, como por ejemplo / m/ y /n/ o /b/ y /v/.

Al comenzar a deletrear, el concursante podrá parar y comenzar de nuevo, deletreando la palabra desde el comienzo; no obstante, al volver a deletrearla, no podrá haber cambio de letras o de su secuencia con respecto a lo que deletreó la primera vez. Para reiniciar su deletreo, el participante debe indicar que lo hará, repitiendo de nuevo la palabra completa antes de deletrearla. Si el participante lo necesitara, puede solicitar que el pronouncer le repita la palabra.

Si el participante está deletreando un término compuesto de dos o más palabras, deberá indicar en inglés los espacios entre las mismas (**space/dash/hyphen**).

En el caso de que la palabra a deletrear incluyera una apóstrofe, el concursante deberá indicar en inglés **apostrophy**.

Las palabras con dos consonantes o dos vocales pueden deletrearse como **double letter** o **letter letter**.

Las palabras cuya primera letra sea una mayúscula deberán deletrearse como **Capital** y la letra correspondiente después de haber abierto la palabra.



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Si pasaran dos rondas de deletreo entre los alumnos de cada grupo, y aún no se ha obtenido un ganador, la organización, previo aviso a los concursantes, hará uso de un listado de palabras extras numeradas de cada grupo. Estas palabras se eligen siguiendo las mismas normas que para la elección de las palabras de los listados anexos.

Si se acabaran las palabras de las listas anexas según cada grupo, un responsable de la organización volverá a meter todas las tarjetas numeradas en la bolsa, pudiendo entonces repetirse las palabras a deletrear.

El proceso se repetirá hasta que sólo quede un concursante que será el GANADOR en su grupo (Grupo 1, Grupo 2).

- Obsequio para el 2º clasificado de cada grupo
- Diploma de reconocimiento a todos los participantes
- Obsequio para el centro educativo al que pertenezca el ganador de cada grupo
