FLASH FICTION CONTEST

Flash Fiction Contest is an international fiction story contest in English promoted by AMCO IBERIA for 5th and 6th grade students.

Participants:

Any student that is enrolled in an AMCO program and currently in their 5th or 6th year of Primary.

Objectives:

1. To develop creative and analytical thinking skills through written task.
2. To develop technical writing skills.
3. To stimulate imagination and develop personal writing style.
4. To offer a safe environment for self-expression, reflection and personal growth through written task.
5. To provide a community and audience to showcase participant work.

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Guidelines:

Participants who enter the **Flash Fiction Contest** will be given a writing prompt that they will be able to submit, at the earliest, on **March 18th**. The students will then have until the contest deadline to brainstorm, develop and revise their writing for submission. They must submit the final copy of their work following these guidelines:

- The text must be typed with **Times New Roman, size 12, double spaced, and submitted by PDF. Maximum 15 MB.**
- The text must be between a **minimum of 150 words and a maximum of 1000 words.**
- The text must be submitted with the **title of their work, their name, their grade, their school, and city / town.**
- The text must be **submitted by April 19th 12:00 p.m.**
- The text must be **written by the individual.** Any text plagiarized or, in fact, not produced by the writers themselves, will result in disqualification.

Writing Prompts:

Participants should choose their Creative Writing Short Story from **one** of the prompts below:

1. Create a Bed Time Story.
2. Write a short story using these three words: detective, piano, school.
3. Imagine you get a magic sweater for your birthday. Write a story about what happens when you wear the sweater. What do you do with these new-found magical powers?

Evaluation Criteria:

Once the participants submit their work, it will be given to a table of judges of AMCO personnel that will read and evaluate all of the submissions. The submissions will be divided into two categories:

- **Category 1:** Participants enrolled in 5th of Primary.
- **Category 2:** Participants enrolled in 6th of Primary.

Judges will evaluate the submissions keeping three bases in mind:

- **Originality (40%):** Judges will look for original and creative content. The story should be interesting and should catch the reader’s attention. The Voice is clear, confident, convincing and consistent.
- **Structure (30%):** Judges will look for a clear structured storyline with sufficient character development as well as a clear introduction, plot and conclusion. The ideas should be organized to support a desired effect, arranged in paragraphs, and the paragraphs should keep a logical order of ideas.
- **Technical Excellence (30%):** Judges will look for the proper use of the English language regarding grammar, punctuation, vocabulary (word choice), spelling, capitalization and sentence structure and fluency. There should be use of a wide range of basic and complex structures and vocabulary; with minimal errors or that the errors do not cloud the meaning. Should be easy to read!

Submission Process:

Prizes:

The judges, after reading all submissions and evaluating them based on the given criteria, will select three winners from each Category.

- **First Place:** Smart Pen and Amco gift
- **Second Place:** Amco gift
- **Third Place:** Amco gift
